



Transition to Work Program (TTW)

Northcott Disability Services Transition to Work Program offers school leavers with a disability, a flexible, innovative and individualised service. The Program provides opportunities for individuals to work towards greater independence, enhance skills, knowledge, confidence and self esteem to enable transition to the employment of their choice. The Program provides a person centred approach which aims to meet the individual needs and goals of the young person.

About the service

The program is primarily a group program which operates from Northcott facilities which are fully-accessible. The program is available for up to 3 days a week.

The program offers the following range of activities:

- Specifically designed Work Skills Training Course
- Over 100 Online Training Courses - Statement of Attainment to Diploma Level
- Support through external education programs e.g.TAFE or University
- Individual Tutorial Support
- Free access to other Northcott Services e.g. Occupational Therapist Assessments, Computer and Assistive Technology Service (CATS)
- Travel training
- Vocational and career guidance
- Work Experience
- Accessible software training
- Independent living skills such as cooking

Eligibility

To be eligible for the program, the individual must:

- Be in receipt of PSO or Transition to Work Program funding provided by Department of Ageing, Disability and Home Care.
- Have a disability which meets the criteria of the Program.

Hours

The program is available for up to 3 days a week. The days of attendance for each individual will vary according to their individual needs.

Fees

Costs associated with programs, such as train fares, movie tickets, are the responsibility of the individual.
