



Northcott Early Childhood and Family Support (NECAFS) - Illawarra

The Northcott Early Childhood and Family Support Service (NECAFS) provides support to families who have a child with a diagnosed disability. The service aims to promote the inclusion of children with disabilities into mainstream services and the wider community.

Services

- providing support through home and community visits with families
- locating suitable therapy services, playgroups, child care centres and schools
- finding parent education and support groups
- sourcing information about child development, educational resources and how to assist the child's learning through play.

Eligibility

Families with a child with a diagnosed disability aged 0-5 years who live in the Wollongong, Shellharbour and Kiama local government areas.

Funding

The service is funded by Ageing Disability and Home Care, Department of Human Services NSW (ADHC) as part of their EarlyStart initiative to support children and families, the program is also supported by Northcott Disability Services, a charity established 80 years ago.
