Mainstream OOSH services are funded to support working parents caring for children aged 12 to 18 years of age. Northcott Disability Services OOSH program is a unique service that provides vacation care to young people with moderate to severe disabilities.

OOSH is a vacation care program for young people with disabilities. The recreation program operates daily between the hours of 8am and 6pm during school holidays and is based at Mainsbridge Special School (118 Flowerdale Road, Liverpool NSW 2170).

Young people help plan their own community-based activities according to their interests and the needs of both individuals and the group as a whole. If, at a particular time, an outing is not possible, the facilities at Mainsbridge School offer an amenable alternative.

Young people between the ages of 12 to 18 years who have a disability with moderate to high support needs. The program can accommodate up to ten participants with priority given to those with working parents.
