Jobmatch can provide Transition to Work support to those who:

- Have a physical disability
- Live within the local government areas of West, South-West and Inner-West Sydney
- Have been assessed as being eligible to receive Transition to Work funding from DADHC
- Willing to gain vocational skills.

Transition to Work programs are jointly-funded by the Department of Ageing, Disability and Home Care and Northcott Disability Services.
